Library	Name of the municipality. The shortened library name follows when there is more than one independent library in the community.
Last Renovated in	Year in which the current main library building was most recently renovated.
Meeting Rooms: High Speed Internet	In the main library, the availability of high speed Internet access (e.g., DSL, T1, cable modem) in the largest meeting room.
Meeting Rooms: Largest Seating Capacity	In the main library, the number of auditorium style seats that can be accommodated in the largest meeting room, or the capacity as determined by the Fire or Building Inspector.
Meeting Rooms: Number of	Total number of room(s) in the main or branch library where two or more members of the public may meet after reserving the space with library staff. This includes conference rooms, auditoriums, general program rooms and rooms where ESL and literacy training takes place. Excluded are rooms dedicated to such activities as computer training labs and quiet and/or group study rooms. Also excluded are areas that are normally public service areas, such as reference, children's and local history rooms.
Meeting Rooms: Wifi in Largest	In the main library, the availability of wireless Internet access in the largest meeting room.

A quiet study room is self-contained and therefore different from a designated, open quiet Browsing Area or Reading Room. Quiet study rooms include tiny rooms that seat 1 or 2 people and a computer; however, if such a space does not have a door it is not a quiet study room.
